
Applicant Portal Enhancements

The following enhancement is available for the Applicant Portal as part of Sprint 15.

Official OAT Scores

Note that this enhancement is immediately available and does not require any configuration.

We are excited to announce that official OAT scores are now received and processed in the OptomCAS application. Applicants can use an OptomCAS-specific OAT code to report their scores to the application. Officially received scores are listed in the **Check Status** tab and in the full application PDF.

Official OAT Scores

Note that this enhancement is immediately available and does not require any configuration.

We are excited to announce that official OAT scores are now received and processed in the OptomCAS application. Admissions users can view the officially received scores in WebAdMIT under the **Standardized Tests** panel.



Prerequisite Course Report

Note that this new functionality will automatically be available for the 2018-2019 cycle for CASs using Prerequisites. This feature can be activated for the current cycle upon request. Contact your Account Manager if you have any questions.

We are excited to announce a new report type: the *Prerequisite Courses* report. This file extracts the courses matched to a program's prerequisites, either by applicants in the application, if enabled, or by admissions users in WebAdMIT. The applicant's **CAS ID**, **prerequisite category name**, **course prefix**, **course name**, **course subject**, **course credits**, **applicant-reported** and **CAS grades**, and **course type** fields are included.


You can locate this report under the **Report Manager** in the **Applicant** report group, and it produces as a .csv file type.

Applicant Details in Association Portal

Note that this enhancement is immediately available and does not require any configuration.

We are excited to announce that association-level users can now view more applicant details in WebAdMIT, including data in the **Contact Information**, **Designation**, **Documents**, **Evaluations**, and **Notes** panels. Association-level users also now have access to the **Search Applicants** page, which includes an **Organization** filter option.

Please note that this enhancement affects the 2014-2015 cycle and later.




Assignment Emails

Note that this new functionality will automatically be available for the 2018-2019 cycle. This feature can be activated for the current cycle upon request. Contact your Account Manager if you have any questions.

We are excited to announce automatic emails for reviewers who are given an Assignment in WebAdMIT. The automatic emails will be sent daily, or weekly on Mondays, to anyone who has incomplete assignments. If you participate in several CASs in WebAdMIT and are assigned an Assignment, you will receive an email for each of your CASs (e.g. one email for incomplete assignments in CASPA, one email for incomplete assignments in ADEA DHCAS, etc).

The automatic emails will be sent to the email address that your WebAdMIT account is set up with. You can disable the email reminders, if needed, under your account settings.




Designation Added Date

Note that this new functionality is a configurable feature option available for the 2018-2019 cycle. Depending on your cycle dates, this feature may be available in the 2017-2018 cycle. Contact your Account Manager if you have any questions.

We are excited to announce that when applicants add a designation to their application, the date added is recorded and transferred to WebAdMIT. This field, labeled as **Program Added**, is located under **Details** in the **Designations** panel. You can also search by it in the List Manager and extract it in the Export Manager.

If an applicant removes a designation and later re-adds it, the new date added is recorded in WebAdMIT.

Resolved Issues

Applicant Portal

The following issues are resolved in the Applicant Portal as part of the Sprint 15 release. The codes in parentheses correspond to the identifiers in our issue tracking system.

- 1. An issue that caused reapplicant information to only be pulled from the previous cycle that had no data, rather than earlier cycles that did have data, was resolved. (UNCAS-12887)
- 2. A display issue that caused parts of security questions to not appear after selecting them was resolved. (UNCAS-13022)
- 3. An issue that recorded the **Expiration Date** in coupon codes as one day earlier was resolved. (UNCAS-13440)
- 4. An issue that allowed applicants who ordered Professional Transcript Entry to submit their application without completing the **Program Materials** section was resolved. (UNCAS-13552)
- 5. An issue that listed the incorrect states once a country is selected in the Evaluation Portal was resolved. (UNCAS-13568)
- 6. An issue that caused undelivered applicants' manual designations to change to undelivered was resolved. (UNCAS-13586)

WebAdMIT

The following issues are resolved in WebAdMIT as part of the Sprint 15 release. The codes in parentheses correspond to the identifiers in our issue tracking system.

- 1. An issue that caused **Manual Designations** not to include correct data in the **Program Identifier** field was resolved. (WA-4888)
- 2. **Manual Designations** were updated to include previously missing data in the **Program Identifier** field. (WA-4889)
- 3. A display issue that listed the **Visa Country code** rather than **Visa Country name** under the **Personal Information** panel, **Citizenship and Residency** subpanel was resolved. (WA-4918)
- 4. An issue that caused the **Export Manager** to not pull the correct number of "many" fields for exports run on no applicants was resolved. (WA-4925)
- 5. An issue that caused incorrect applicant totals in the **Race and Ethnicity** report was resolved. (WA-4945)
- 6. A display issue that listed code instead of text in the tool tip for the **Designation** field in the **Search** page was resolved. (WA-4953)
