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New Features and Enhancements

Applicant Portal Enhancements

The following enhancements are available for the Applicant Portal as part of Sprint 16.

New Required Questions on the Applicant Portal

The Applicant Portal now requires applicants, based on the CAS/UniCAS, to answer one or both of the following questions:

- When do you plan to begin your program (**Program Plans**)?
- Can we text you (**Text Notifications**)?

These questions appear in a dialog box in the core application. The **Program Plans** question provides visibility into an applicant's intentions, helps explain why some applicants don't apply, and identifies candidates to target for Reminder Email/SMS campaigns. The **Text Notifications** question allows an applicant to opt into text messaging for communications from the CAS and programs; you may use this information to send text messages outside of the Applicant Portal.
