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
New Features and Enhancements

New Custom Question Types

Two new question types are available for the custom questions that your program creates in the Configuration Manager. Applicants will see these new question types in the **Questions** tab of the Program Materials section of the application and the Applicant PDF.

Date

Use the new **Date** question type when you want applicants to enter an answer as a date.





Numeric

Use the new **Numeric** question type when you want applicants to enter an answer as a number. You can then set a maximum number of characters that applicants can enter (not including decimal points).

Resolved Issues

WebAdMIT

The following issues are resolved in WebAdMIT as part of the Sprint 3 release. The codes in parentheses correspond to the identifiers in our issue tracking system.

1. An issue that in certain instances prevented email templates from loading when users searched for in-progress applicants was resolved. (WA-4561)
2. WebAdMIT now correctly saves changes when you assign email templates to programs. (WA-4558)
3. An issue that prevented certain obsolete applicant-uploaded documents from being deleted was resolved. (WA-4416)
4. Duplicate Degrees and Majors were removed from WebAdMIT. (WA-4553)
5. An issue that prevented users from searching by Academic Update Status was resolved. (WA-4557)
6. Updates were made to the messages users see when making a local status change to a batch of applicants. (WA-4514)
7. An issue where Parent Names were missing for certain applicants was resolved. (UNCAS-11602)
8. Users now receive an error message if they try to re-order questions and remarks after an interview is assigned. (WA-4170)
9. After a batch action is completed, WebAdMIT now correctly returns users to the list of applicants they were previously viewing. (WA-3408)

Applicant Portal

The following issues are resolved in the Applicant Portal as part of the Sprint 3 release. The codes in parentheses correspond to the identifiers in our issue tracking system.

1. An issue where changes to application statuses in the Applicant Portal did not update correctly in WebAdMIT was resolved. (UNCAS-11698)
2. Where applicable, applicants in AU Received and AU Complete statuses are now prevented from editing the Transcript Entry section to avoid submission of multiple Academic Updates. Sections re-open for editing once applicants are in AU Verified status. (UNCAS-11654)
3. An issue that in certain instances prevented verified PTE applicants from reviewing and finalizing their transcripts was resolved. (UNCAS-10433)
