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## New Features and Enhancements

### WebAdMIT Enhancements

The following enhancements are available for WebAdMIT as part of Sprint 12.

#### New WebAdMIT User Interface Option Available

We are excited to announce that a new user interface option is now available for WebAdMIT users. The new interface has a modern, streamlined look and feel, with easier-to-use navigation. All WebAdMIT functionality remains the same.

Your CAS can opt to enable this new interface for all users in the CAS. If enabled, each individual user can click **New User Interface** at the top right-corner of WebAdMIT to try out the new interface. If they want to go back to the classic interface, they can click **Old User Interface** to toggle back. Please contact your Account Manager for more information or to enable this option.

If your CAS chooses not to enable the new interface option, users will not be able to access the new user interface; however, it will be automatically enabled at the start of your next cycle so we encourage you to try it out and let us know what you think!

## Resolved Issues

### WebAdMIT

The following issues are resolved in WebAdMIT as part of the Sprint 12 release. The codes in parentheses correspond to the identifiers in our issue tracking system.

1. Designation data now appears correctly in the **Local Status Summary** report. Previously, the designations displayed were higher than the actual number of designations. (WA-4853)
2. Non-Institution Managers can now search for deactivated admissions users. Previously, these users did not have the option to search by this criterion which prevented them from viewing deactivated users. (WA-4836)
3. Each Local GPA and Local Status must now have a unique name. Previously, it was possible to create a new Local GPA using an existing Local GPA name, and a new Local Status using an existing Local Status name. This change resolves potential confusion and errors. (WA-4611)
4. A **Send Draft Email** (envelope) icon is now available on the **Search Correspondence** page. Click this icon to send emails that you saved as drafts. (WA-4602)
5. Multiple assignment and interview results now display correctly and in the expected order on the **Applicant Details** page. Previously, results displayed on top of each other and did not close automatically when new ones were opened. (WA-4578)
6. A blank report now generates if you attempt to export or report on a clipboard that does not contain any applicants. Previously, the export or report failed and did not provide a clear error message. (WA-4465)
7. The **Scoring** panel now refreshes correctly when you click **Refresh Applicant Scores**. Previously, the page did not display correctly after a refresh. (WA-2887)
8. Custom Questions created using HTML in the Configuration Portal now display without the HTML code in the **Custom Questions** panel in WebAdMIT. (WA-2062)

## Applicant Portal

The following issues are resolved in the Applicant Portal as part of the Sprint 12 release. The codes in parentheses correspond to the identifiers in our issue tracking system.

1. If an applicant selects **Other > International** as their **Country of Legal Residence** in the **Family Information** section, the information now appears correctly in the application PDF. Previously, the **Other > International** option incorrectly appeared as **Cape Verde** in the PDF. (UNCAS-12814)
2. An issue that caused organization-level questions to be incorrectly deleted when applicants removed designations was resolved. Now, when applicant remove designations, their answers to organization-level questions are only removed if the applicant has no designations remaining for that organization. (UNCAS-12752)
3. The **Professional Transcript Entry (PTE)** page header now displays the CAS Customer Service email address. Previously, that information was missing from the header. (UNCAS-12079)
4. A more accurate message now appears in the **Evaluations** section of the **Check Status** tab for programs that do not require evaluations. It now displays as “No evaluations are required for this program” instead of “You have not requested evaluations needed for this program.” (UNCAS-11554)
5. An issue where schools could not be deleted from the **Colleges Attended** page was resolved. (UNCAS-13226)
